The June meeting of the NWVMA will be held on Wednesday evening, June 11th at **Jake’s Supper Club on Tainter Lake** in Menomonie, which is located a few miles north of Menomonie on County Road D. Changes also include clarification on several definitions including “client” and “advertising”. There have also been updates on the “delegation of veterinary services to certified veterinary technicians”, and “unprofessional conduct”. Our speaker will be Kim Brown Pokorny, our WVMA Executive Director from Madison. We hope you can join us for an informative evening on these recent rule changes. The program will count one continuing education (CE) credit.
