“VFD” by Dr. Matt Boyle & “Food Armor™” by Dr. Katie Mrdutt

The June meeting of the NWVMA will be held on Wednesday evening, June 10<sup>th</sup>, at the **Horizons Lounge & Banquet Center** in Tilden at the intersections of highway 53, highway B and highway Q (5 miles north of Chippewa Falls on Highway 53). The evening program will focus on new regulations and management plans for drug use in food producing animals. New regulations related to drugs that are fed to animals will be discussed by Dr. Matt Boyle from Zoetis. This is the Veterinary Feed Directive (VFD) which limits drugs in or on animal feed to only be used under the professional supervision of a licensed veterinarian. The industry is in the midst of a phase-in period by the FDA-CVM which desires all uses of medically important drugs (including all antibiotics) in feed or water for food producing animals to be under veterinary control. Dr. Katie Mrdutt, WVMA outreach veterinarian, will provide an overview of the WVMA Food Armor™ program. This program is a Hazards Analysis and Critical Control Points (HACCP) plan for proper drug use in farm animals. Dr. Mrdutt will give an overview of the contents of the full two day WVMA Food Armor™ training workshop. Please join us for an informative evening on the current drug use regulations and management plans in food producing animals. The program will count one continuing education (CE) credit.
