These new technologies enable dairy herd managers to monitor the production, health, and activity of individual cows within a dairy herd. Recent research findings and interpretations of cow information will be discussed. The presenters will be Tom Breunig and Steve Pavelski from SCR Dairy in Madison (<http://www.scrdairy.com>).
